This Foundation has done, for many years, remarkable and unique work via a 'Pick Me Up' service which began back in 1998 and has grown from humble beginnings of 400 trips a year to now over 11,500! These are people who, without the Foundation, would be virtually abandoned. They are elderly people who have no way of getting to a doctor's appointment. They are veterans of several theatres of war who have no one to get them to essential services that they regularly seek.

The 'Pick Me Up' service provides extraordinary and unprecedented support for such worthy yet needy people in our community.

The Foundation also seeks to secure the independence of such people, to enable them to remain within their home and local community but benefit from services that local networks can bring.




#### **PICK ME UP SERVICE**

### No of TRIPS

A record 11520 Trips was recorded for the 2017/18 financial year. Eastern Suburbs with 43.37 % continues to lead the regions with the Inner West (29.0%) our major growth area overtaking Sydney City (27%).

This years result has seen demand for our services increase by over 16% from last year and 94 % since 2010.




#### PICK ME UP SERVICE COSTS

The Foundation continues to be conscious about its costs structure and the importance of becoming more productive ,efficient and sustainable.

Remarkably even allowing for the increase in bookings of 49% over the past 5 years the Foundation cost per trip once again decreased to \$31.32 in costs per booking.

Overall costs in this area since 2010/11 as decreased by 123%!




## **EVENTS** GOVERNORS RECEPTION March 2018


